#### Pennsylvania Adult Autism Services

The information shared in this <u>site</u> is intended to communicate the Department of Human Services' efforts to enhance the quality of life and independence of Pennsylvanians with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), and to support their families and caregivers. The Office of Developmental Programs (ODP) supports children and adults with autism through services and supports available in four waivers—<u>Adult Autism Waiver</u> (AAW), <u>Community Living Waiver</u> (CLW), <u>Consolidated Waiver</u> and <u>Person Family Directed Support Waiver</u> (PFDS), In addition, the <u>Adult Community Autism Program</u> (ACAP), is available to adults with autism living in Chester County. *Each waiver and program has different eligibility and availability. It is important to read all the information to make sure that your student qualifies prior to applying.* If you have any questions, feel free to reach out to Beth Heinz and we can work together to better understand your options.
